What a difference a month makes. We want to keep the golf course open as long as we can. We need your help to make this happen. Please adhere to the Federal, State, CDC, & Golf Course requirements & recommendations:

- Social distancing of 6'
- No more than 4 in the Pro Shop at one time
 - Wash & sanitize hands frequently
 - Do not touch the Flagstick
 - Do not touch other's clubs
- No handshakes before, during, or after round
- DO NOT come to golf course if feeling sick
 - Do not hang out in the Pro Shop

Note: We have removed all rakes, ball washers, & water jugs.

To help stop the spread we do our best to:

- Sanitize most frequently touched surfaces on the hour
- Wash and sanitize golf carts & keys before passing out
 - Sanitize restrooms on the hour
- Offer individual carts upon request and when available

Please do your part by bringing and using your own sanitizers and wipes.

Our world seems to be changing at a rapid pace. We are doing our best to keep you safe and provide a relaxing and enjoyable outlet. Our current goal is to convert to a less surface touching golf course. We are asking people not to touch the flag sticks and adding foam in the cups that will not allow the ball to drop to the bottom, making it easier to remove with minimal if no contact to surfaces. I am sure you have noticed we have removed all water jugs, ball washers and bunker rakes, as this will help minimize touching surfaces as well. Challenging and different times but we will navigate through it.

Pro Tip of the Month

Want to improve your game? You need to improve the way you practice. I see many of you hitting range balls (and that is a good thing) but I don't see many of you practicing the short game. If you want to get better determine the amount of time your practice session will be and then split it in 1/3's:

1/3 putting & chipping

1/3 pitching & bunkers

1/3 driving range

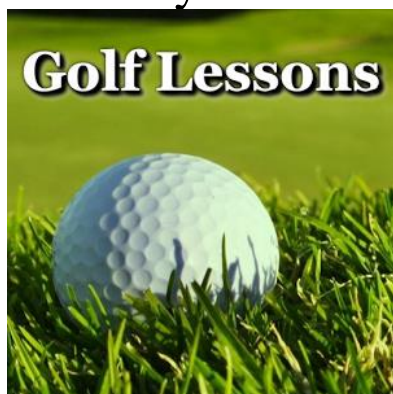
