We are planning on opening the tees we rebuilt sometime before Easter weekend. We will continue to resurface tees on #2, #6, and #7 throughout the season. Aerification is also planned for the 18th and 19th of this month. We will be doing a conventional core aerification. We will do the front nine on Monday and the back nine Tuesday. Turf Tip of the Month

When temperatures stay in the mid 60's for lows it is time to start fertilizing warm season grasses. This is also time to treat for fire ants and mole crickets.

Rule of the Month

Question: There is a leaf behind my ball in a bunker. Can I move it?

Answer: Yes, you now can move loose impediments in a bunker or penalty area.

Pro Tip of the Month

The transition of your backswing and downswing is critical in hitting solid, accurate golf shots. The transition sets the tone for your swing path which dictates the direction the ball starts out. A loose casting move at the top will cause the club to cross the line and the ball will start out left of your target (right for lefties). This is the most common mistake. If you drop the club inside the line, the ball will start out to the right of your target (left for lefties). This is rare for golfers. There are a number of reasons why we make these mistakes.

1. Grip too loose at transition
2. Popping your hips
3. Bad alignment
4. Flying elbow
5. Spine angle change

If you are having this problem but unsure why, give me a call. I'll be glad to work with you to figure it out.

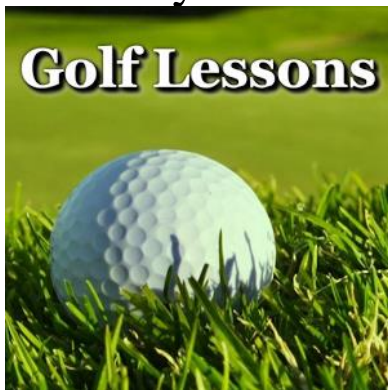
