Now is the time to start planning on fall pre-emergent herbicide for the fall. As we get to the end of the month you will want to stay away from high nitrogen fertilization and go with higher P&K rates.

Pro Tip of the Month

Keep your right hand connected during transition

Nearly eight out of ten people I teach have a problem with keeping their right hand connected with their left (opposite for lefties) during the transition of their back swing and down swing. This problem will cause many of your miss hits like “pulling the ball”, “snap pull hooks” & “topping the ball”. One way to check to see if you have this problem is to take a back swing and stop it at the top. Then look at the palm of your right hand and see if it is still touching your left thumb. If there is any separation at all, you would be one of the eight I mentioned above. This is one of the most important pressure points of the grip. Keep pressure on your left thumb with your right palm during the transition to correct the problem. If you correct this problem, straighter and more solid shots will follow.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.

Rule of the Month

Question: I marked my ball on the putting green. After replacing it, a gust of wind came and blew my ball off the green. Do I have to play it from the new position?

Answer: Since you marked and replaced it, you must replace the ball as closely to the spot it moved from. If you did not mark it and then it moved, you would have to play it where it moved from to.

Rule: 13.1d2

Tee it Forward!!!

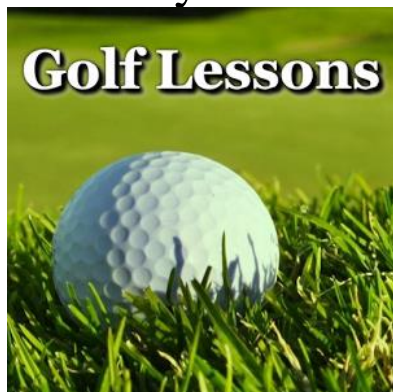
