The end of another growing season is a upon us. This means that Holidays are right around the corner. One behalf of the maintenance crew, I would like to thank you for all the support and wish you a safe and Happy Holiday Season.

Frost delays are as much of an inconvenience for superintendents as they are for you. We have already experienced two delays this year. Agronomic principles prevent us from allowing you to play on frosted turf. Each frost delay is unique and there is no set answer for handling frost. 38 degrees Fahrenheit (read at the maintenance shop thermometer) seems to be the magic number. If the air temperature in the shade is less than 38 degrees, frost remains. Rest assured that we utilize all available resources to prepare the golf course for play as soon as possible following a frost delay. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

Turf Tip of the Month

Fallen leaves will utilize plant nutrients in the process of breaking down. It is important to remove leaves from your lawn. If you can store and harvest leaves and debris, they will make great compost this time next year. Hold off on pruning ornamental trees and shrubs until mid-January to late February (only prune during months that end in "ARY"). Insect and disease damage is still possible if you prune too early.

Pro Tip of the Month

Feet together drill

Think you have a balance problem? This is a great way to check to find out. It is also a great drill to fix your imbalance. Tee up a ball (always use a tee when doing any kind of drill), take a normal stance with a 7- iron, then narrow your stance together (no more than a club head apart), swing the club and finish with a normal follow through. Make sure your back heel is pointing at the sky. You should be able to do this without fighting to hold the follow through. If you can't do it, you have a balance problem and need to continue using the drill to fix it.

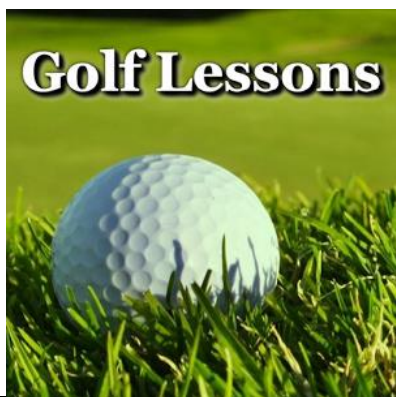
