We have several projects that will be getting started this month. We have a contractor coming in to clear the back right of the driving range. We will be replacing the old poles and netting. The range will need to be closed while this work is being done. We have another contractor coming in to dredge around our pump house. This will have little disruption of play and is needed for our irrigation system. Other projects include tee reconstruction and resurfacing. We also plan on more bunker renovation and ongoing drainage work. Thank you for your understanding as we make these improvements.

Now is the perfect time to get ready for the up coming growing season. It is pruning time for most trees and bushes. Get soil samples sent in if you have not already done so. Start pricing out pre-emergent herbicides to control crabgrass.

Rule of the Month

Question: I saw my playing partner ground his club in a penalty area AND moved a branch out of his way. How many penalty strokes does he get for this?

Answer: He gets none, as long as he didn’t move the ball when removing the branch. You are now allowed to ground your club and remove loose impediments in a penalty area (You can’t ground your club in a bunker)

Rule: 15.1a

Pro Tip of the Month

Constant Grip Pressure

Try to maintain the same grip pressure when you putt, chip, pitch and swing. Don’t be too loose or too tight. Constant pressure will help avoid “flipping” the club at transition.

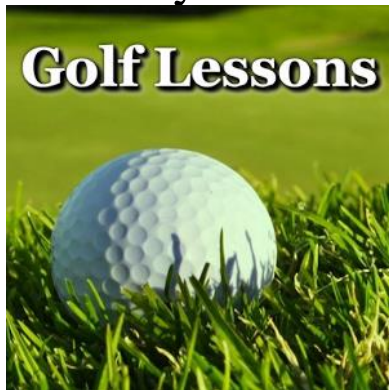
