We are in the transition period. Our bermudagrass is not growing very rapidly due to cooler nighttime temperatures. When overnight temperatures reach 70 degrees Fahrenheit, the bermudagrass will begin to jump.

The “clumpy” plant growth throughout the golf course is a combination of annual bluegrass and ryegrass. These two plants originate from our overseed and are relocated via cart traffic, mower traffic, and foot traffic. They will continue to die out in the next few weeks as temperatures increase, and days grow longer.

We will be aerifying tees & fairways shortly as time and personnel permit. The benefits of aerifying turf include a revitalized, deeper, healthier root system.

We continue to work on the right half of the driving range tee. Irrigation piping has been repaired and we are able to manually water the tee and putting/chipping greens. We are in the process of tracing the electrical lines to the controller and irrigation heads. Once these lines are repaired, sod will be laid, trenches filled in and a portion of the right side tee will be opened.

Turf Tip of the Month

By now you should have completed applying your pre-emergent lawn fertilizer. April is the month to begin applying fertilizer with a post-emergent herbicide to control crabgrass and broadleaf weeds. Get that soil test and make sure you mower blades are sharp. The key to a healthy turf grass stand is “mow it sharp and mow it often.”
