May is finally here! This is one of my favorite months of the year. The weather is just right for growing grass and not yet too hot and humid. This is also when we transition from the cool season grass (rye grass and poa trivialis) on our tees and greens to bermuda grass. During this transition the turf will look a little rough until the bermuda has a chance to fill in.

We worked hard to fix many irrigation issues and hope to finish off some of the drainage projects we opened up back in the winter months. As the month goes on we will ease into our summer mowing patterns. In the fairways we are still trying to get mole crickets under control and will be spraying for carpetgrass.

Pro Tip of the Month

Make the game a lot more fun by playing from the appropriate tees.

Here is an easy way to figure out if you are playing the correct tee markers.

On a normal day with little wind and about 15 yards of roll, if you are hitting more than a 5-iron into #1 after a good tee shot, you need to move up a set of tees.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.

- #6 tee: 125-149 yard avg. drive

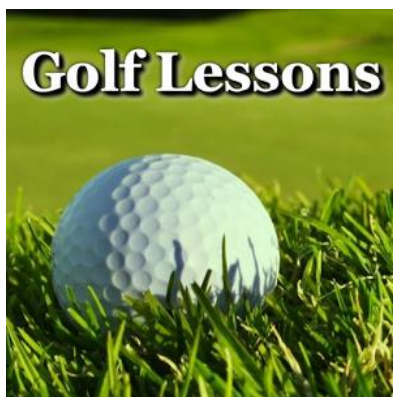
