As we struggle with our insurance company and to get contractors to offer bids, we will be moving into a temporary office trailer beginning on May 5th. We appreciate all the support the membership has offered, not only with kind words but with hard work and donations. So many of you came out to help after the storm. Thank you all so much.

Many of you suggested we started a GoFundMe account, so we did (https://www.gofundme.com/f/cypress-lakes-gc-storm-renovation-fund?qid=f83a20298d2ff87c534f447d9b3d8de6&utm_campaign=p_cp_url&utm_medium=os&utm_source=customer)

The funds will be used to pay the \$10,000+ deductible and for anything uninsured. We want to continue making improvements but with this financial setback, we will have to put capital improvements on hold until everything is sorted out. We will NOT hold back with any basic agronomic practices. Our golf course is in great shape and we plan on keeping it that way for a long time. We have been through so many hurricanes with hardly any clubhouse damage. It's hard to believe all this damage was from a thunderstorm's straight line winds. It is what it is. We will rebuild and hopefully it will be better than before.

Pro Tip of the Month

If your hands sweat a lot you probably wear a glove. To prolong the life of your gloves and for better performance, alternate them between holes. Never wear a glove for two holes in a row. In this heat, I rotate 3 gloves during the round. The gloves dry out before rotated back in to play. Your gloves will last longer and perform better.

DO NOT leave your clubs in your trunk during the summer. The trunks get so hot that it can ruin your grips and it could also loosen the heads of your clubs.

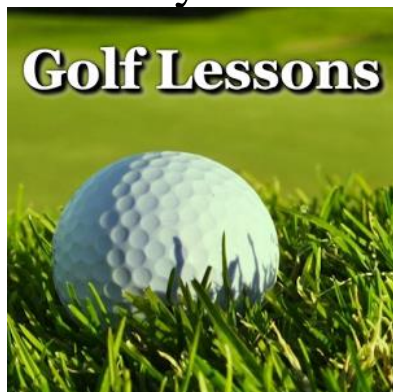
