We will begin overseeding playing surfaces this month. We will begin with tees and collars the week of 5 October. We will overseed greens later in the month (overseeding of greens requires additional preparation prior to actually seeding). Once again, we will seed the tees and collars with perennial ryegrass (*lolium perenne*) and the greens with rough bluegrass (*poa trivialis*). This will require multiple light irrigations (approx 4 mins in duration) to the greens and tees throughout the day. The practice putting green will be closed after seed is applied to allow the seed to germinate and begin rooting.

Turf Tip of the Month

If you plan to overseed your lawn, now is the time. Be sure to keep the seed moist until it germinates. This will require multiple light irrigations throughout the day. Apply just enough water to moisten the seed. Once the seed has germinated, water deep and infrequent to promote strong roots. An application of fertilizer high in Phosphorous (such as 9-2-24 or 5-10-31) will aid in germination and early rooting. Cool season turfgrass requires a half inch of water per week. Too much water will increase disease pressure and severely affect spring transition. If you do not overseed, this is a great time to apply a pre-emergent fertilizer (such as Pre-emergent 5-10-20).

Pro Tip of the Month

Do your elbows separate at the top of your back swing? If they do, you can put yourself in the category with so many that have "flying elbows". If you are not sure, have someone measure how close your elbows are at address, take a back swing and stop it at the top then measure again. If they are equal you can eliminate "flying elbows" as a problem. If not, then you need to work on keeping them closer together. This is one of the top reasons for swing plane problems. "Flying elbows" cause an outside in swing path, which promotes a big pull hook or a big slice. Either one is not very good. One way to keep your elbows close at the top of your back swing, is to point your right elbow to the ground (left elbow for lefties). Another way is to point the pads of your thumbs to the sky. The only good thing about the "flying elbow" is that it can be cured. You have to know you are doing it to fix it.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.
