Green speed should begin to increase as the grain decreases. If soil temperatures allow, we will begin overseeding the greens with Poa Trivilas and tees with perennial (3-way) rye. We will also be applying pre-emergent to the fairways and surrounds.

Torpedograss, Goosegrass, Crabgrass and Nutsedge are the weeds we are in the process of controlling. Herbicides used to control these weeds will cause some temporary yellowing to Bermudagrass. Expect this yellowing on the greens, fairways, tees, green and tee slopes over the next few weeks as we attempt to eliminate weeds.

Pro Tip of the Month

How is your balance?
Do you slide your hips?
A great drill to determine if you sway,
slide, or dip your head is:

THE SHADOW DRILL

This only works on a sunny day where
you can see your shadow. Get the sun at
your back so that your shadow is
directly in front of you. Take a slow
practice swing all the way back, and
back to the impact position. If you can
do this without moving your shadow,
you are doing better than most.

After impact, the shadow does move
towards your target.
The closer you get to not moving your
shadow, the more consistent your shots
will be.
