October is starting off hot and dry. It is very important that we have health turf before we overseed and go into dormancy. We do our best to insure that by spoon feeding the turf with Phosphorus & Potassium fertilizer and stay away from high rates of Nitrogen. Adding Magnesium will also help maintain color without the surge of growth.

As the temperatures start to drop and our warm season grasses slow down in growth, we will start on clean up projects. Thank you for your support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

Rule of the Month

Question: I found a ball in high grass which I thought was mine inside the penalty area (red stakes). Thinking it was my ball, I hit it towards the green. I then hit the ball again on the green. After my first putt failed to go in, I realized it was not my ball. That's 3-times with wrong ball before realizing it. What do I do?

Answer: You hit the wrong ball from the penalty area, you must correct the problem and add two strokes. All strokes made with the wrong ball do not count.

Rule: 6.3c

Pro Tip of the Month

You should be able to play the entire round (excluding par 3's) with one tee, two max. If you are breaking tees with just about every drive, your swing plane with the driver is too steep. The driver is designed to hit the ball on the upswing, which causes the tee to roll over. If you hit the drive on the downswing, you are creating a chopping motion that cuts the tee in half. Plus, this chopping motion causes too much backspin & side spin. Swinging up on the ball causes more top spin, which causes the ball to level off and go further. The driver is the only club in your bag that is specifically designed to hit the ball on the upswing. All the other clubs in your bag (except your putter) are designed to hit the ball on the downswing.

Cure: tee the ball up just off your front heel and keep your center (sternum) about four to six inches behind the ball until impact.

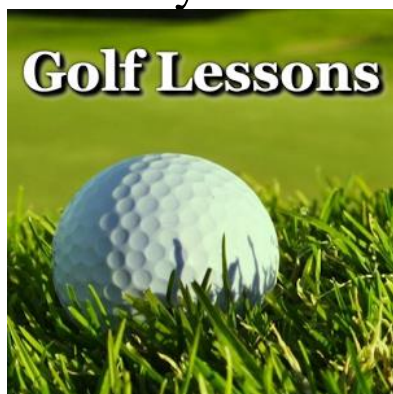
