A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Win Thomas

September will be another busy month as we ready the course for the club championship.

Greens have not recovered as well as we had hoped from the August drill aerification, Heavy grain in the Tifgreen 328 bermuda remains the biggest problem. We continue to address the issue with verticutting, topdressing and application of a plant growth regulator.

This has been a difficult growing season. The turfgrass has had to endure periods of heavy rain, heavy traffic, and numerous pests (weeds being number one). This month, we will apply a herbicide to begin the process of preparing the course for overseeding.

A winter work schedule is being put together at this time. The list includes bunker repairs, drainage work, ornamental transplanting, irrigation repair, dead tree removal and brush clearing. Any comments or concerns you may have in this area would be greatly appreciated. Feel free to stop by or call the office at (850) 937-3887.

Turf Tip of the Month

Late season fertilizer should contain a high percentage of Potassium. There are three numbers on a fertilizer analysis. The first number is Nitrogen, second is Phosphorus, and the last number is Potassium. Potassium is important for root development, increases plant hardiness, and aids in spring green up. *Win*

 - click on "Handicap Verification",
- enter the last name of the person you want to look up.

Procedure 2: To enter scores or to print out handicap. It gets a little more complicated, but follow this procedure to the letter and it will work.

- Go to www.gafgolf.org
 - Enter site
- Golfer Login (username & Login)
- Contact John 937-3820 for username & login if you do not know them
 - Enter Score


