This League is designed to SAFELY get the kids out of the house, play the game they love, interact with their friends, enjoy friendly competition, give Mom & Dad a few hours of ME time, and hopefully to improve their game. It will be more of a practice and play on own league rather than a fully based instructional league. I will be there providing guidance and instruction from a safe distance.

I would like to have at least 2 teams. Group will be split into teams of 4 or 5 depending on entries (Max 15 juniors). There will also be individual competitions. The group WILL be adhering to CDC guidelines requiring social distancing. Juniors will be playing their own ball during Team Play (no scrambles). Driving range sessions will be split in 2-3 groups (chipping & putting, pitching & bunkers, driving range). Everyone will be walking each session.

Every Tuesday we will have a Short Game Skill Challenge: Putting, chipping, pitching, and bunkers

**Team Play:**

Team placement and qualifying rounds will be based on your performance in the first 3 practice sessions. The competition will begin over the last 5 sessions. Your position on the team will be your average score over the first 3 practices and will change according to your tournament scores. Team score will be the best 4 of 5 or the best 3 of 4 depending on the team size.

September should be a little drier and less humid if we can avoid getting any tropical systems coming our way. We are still busy with mowing and set up on a daily basis. This month we are also spraying pre and post herbicides to suppress weeds.

Our continued goal is and always will be to improve the golf course. The excessive rain we have had the past few weeks has not only made it challenging to mow but also to do routine maintenance practices. One thing you can help with is by keeping the carts (and pull carts) out of wet areas and on the cart paths around the tees and greens. I prefer not to put ropes out and with your help, I won't be forced to. Thank you for your support as we strive to make Cypress Lakes Golf Club a fun place to play golf.

**Turf tip:**

Late season fertilizer should contain a high percentage of Potassium. There are three numbers on a fertilizer analysis. The first number is Nitrogen, second is Phosphorus, and the last number is Potassium. Potassium is important for root development, increases plant hardiness, and aids in spring green up.

## Pro Tip of the Month

It's HOT!!

If your hands sweat a lot, you probably wear a glove. To prolong the life of your gloves and for better performance, alternate them between holes. Never wear a glove for two holes in a row. In this heat, I rotate 3 gloves during the round. The gloves dry out before rotated back in to play. Your gloves will last longer and perform better.

DO NOT leave your clubs in your trunk during the summer. The trunks get so hot that it can ruin your grips and it could also loosen the heads of your clubs.

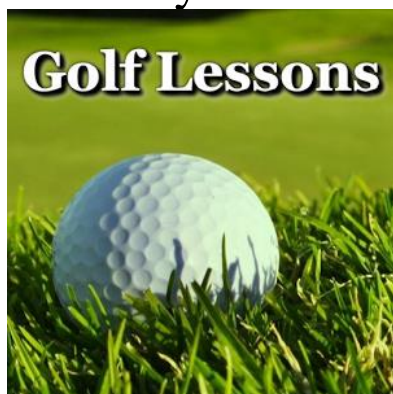
