Superintendent: Win Thomas**

This has been a difficult growing season. The turf grass has had to endure periods of heavy rain, high evening humidity, heavy traffic and numerous pests. All things considered, we have done very well. This month, we will apply an herbicide to begin the process of preparing the course for over seeding.

We received over 22" of rain in July (over 67" for the year to date). As you know, the course remains very wet. Please respect the "wet area", cart directional signs and ropes we have in place to divert cart traffic from these areas.

A winter work schedule is being put together at this time. The list includes drainage work, ornamental transplanting, irrigation repair, dead tree removal and brush clearing. Pro Tip of the Month

Most people that play the game have their hands too far away from their body. This will cause you to lean into the ball resulting in shanks, fat shots, or if you overcorrect, the results will be thin shots or tops. All of these are bad. A good rule of thumb is to let your arms hang down naturally at address. Once you grip the club, the end of the grip should be about a fist from your body. Watch the guys on tv. Almost all have their hands very close. Jim Furyk's hands almost touch his body.

Set the club behind the ball where it needs to be at impact. Then walk into the club not changing the club position or club angle (45 degrees to the ground) until the end of the grip is about a fist from your body.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.
