A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Win Thomas

Transition is complete on putting greens. You may have noticed the green putting speed has slowed. This is due to increased grain, which is very common this time of year, in our Tifgreen 328 bermudagrass. We will continue periodic verticutting, light topdressingand rolling throughout the growing season help reduce the effect of grain on putting speed.

Our next "Drill aerification" of the putting greens is scheduled for Monday, August 29th. This is a full day operation that will cause some inconvenience. Please check the tee sheet in advance to limit confusion and frustration. Aerification is one of the necessary evils of golf course management.

Torpedograss, Goosegrass, Crabgrass and Nutsedge are the weeds we are in the process of controlling. Herbicides used to control these weeds will cause some temporary yellowing to Bermudagrass. Expect this yellowing on the greens, fairways, tees, green and tee slopes over the next few weeks as we attempt to eliminate weeds.

Pro Tip of the Month

Does the pressure of your grip change throughout your swing or putting stroke? If you are like most of us, it does. Have you ever even paid attention to it? One of the biggest causes of "the yips" in putting and "the over the top pull hook" in the swing is that the grip pressure increases at the transition point of your backswing and downswing. The next time you practice be conscious of keeping the pressure constant through transition and I promise you will be more fluid with your stroke.

Try these tips and I promise this will help your game.


