## A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Win Thomas

In case you're interested, we have received approx. 94" of rain this year with a month to go in the season (61" is our average annual rainfall).

The end of another growing season is upon us. This means that Holidays are right around the corner. On behalf of the maintenance crew, I would like to thank you for all the support and wish you a safe and Happy Holiday Season.

In spite of the weather, overseeding is complete. Look for green speed to become more consistent as the overseed matures.

Projects planned for this winter include clearing the back of the driving range, improving drainage; continued dead tree removal, privet and debris removal from tree lines, bunker edging and cart path edging.

Frost delays the bane are of superintendents. Agronomic principles prevent us from allowing you to play on frosted turf. Each frost delay is unique and there is no cook book answer for handling frost. 38 degrees Fahrenheit is usually the magic number. If the air temperature in the shade is less than 38 degrees, Rest assured that we use all frost remains. available resources to prepare the golf course for play as soon as possible following a frost delay. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

#### Turf Tip of the Month

Fallen leaves will utilize plant nutrients in the process of breaking down. It is important to remove leaves from your lawn. If you can harvest and store leaves and debris, they will make great compost this time next year. Hold off on pruning ornamental trees and shrubs until mid January to late February (only prune during months that end in "ARY"). Insect and disease damage is still possible if pruning occurs at this time.

Tee it Forward!!! Give it a try. You will have more fun.

#### **Pro Tip of the Month**

Do you rotate your hands and arms on the back swing? If you do, you are going to have a big problem getting the timing down at impact. Practice taking the club back keeping your elbows from separating and without twisting the wrists. Allow the body twisting to bring the club on an inside path.

Now at impact, you want the back of your left hand (right hand for lefties) facing the target. To get it in that position, at impact, it will feel as though the *back* of your left hand (back of your right hand for lefties) is facing the ground just after impact. The reason behind this, the hands and arms are moving so fast that the mind hasn't had a chance to catch up. It feels this way, even though the back of the hand faces the ground at a much later time in the follow through.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game. Good Luck! John
