Transition is about 85% complete on putting greens and scars from our in-house "core" aerification are nearly gone. We will continue periodic verticutting and light topdressing throughout the Bermudagrass growing season to ensure quality playing conditions. Aerification is necessary to control thatch, increase water infiltration, improve nutrient uptake, relieve compaction, and allow for oxygen and carbon dioxide exchange. I know putting on aerified greens is frustrating, but I guarantee the benefits will be worth the inconvenience.

Torpedograss, Goosegrass, and Nutsedge are three weeds we are in the process of controlling. Herbicides used to control these weeds will cause some yellowing to Bermudagrass. Expect this yellowing on the green slopes and tee slopes over the next few weeks as we attempt to eliminate weeds.

Pro Tip of the Month

Does the pressure of your grip change throughout your swing or putting stroke? If you are like most of us, it does. Have you ever even paid attention to it? One of the biggest causes of “the yips” in putting and “the over the top pull hook” in the swing is that the grip pressure increases at the transition point of your backswing and downswing. The next time you practice be conscious of keeping the pressure constant through transition and I promise you will be more fluid with your stroke.

Try these tips and I promise this will help your game.
