**A word from your Golf Course
Superintendent: Win Thomas**

It is the time of year on a golf course that all you hear is “transition”. It is no different here. We are still in the process of transitioning from the cool season overseed into the warm season Bermudagrass. My goal was a transparent transition, where you would not see any changes and more importantly not notice changes in the playing condition. However, the unseasonably warm daytime temperatures, wind and lack of rain have combined to make this year's transition quite a challenge.

We will be aerating putting greens beginning Monday June 10th. The operation will take two days to complete. Restrictions will be placed on use of holes being aerified. Please check the tee sheet at the front desk in the pro shop.

Aeration of the putting fairways, approaches and first cut was just completed. Shortly, we will begin aeration of the tees. Traffic causes our heavy clay soils to compact more rapidly than sandy soils. We use mechanical aerators to create more air space in the soil to promote deeper rooting. Aeration is often followed by sand topdressing to help retain soil air space and promote downward rooting. This process promotes deep, healthy roots which are required for healthy turf.

Pro Tip of the Month

Are you missing putts to the left or right by wide margins?

If so, one of the many possibilities is that you might be twisting your wrists and forearms during the stroke. Concentrate on keeping the back of your lead hand solid and facing the target on the back stroke and through stroke. To check if you are doing it correctly, hold your follow through after the stroke and check the back of your hand. Reduce the twisting and hit more accurate putts.

Try these tips and I promise this will help your game.

Turf Tip of the Month

It is time to control for mole crickets. Some areas have reported egg hatch and control measures are most effective when the crickets are in the nymph stage. There are products available for use by the homeowner which control both mole crickets and fire ants (look for the active ingredient "Bifenthrin" on the label). Please contact your local county extension agent for product recommendations, rates, and timing of application. In Escambia County call 475-5230 and in Santa Rosa County call 623-3868.

Rule of the month

I will be doing a series of rules that relate to each hole here at Cypress Lakes Golf Club. John

Hole #8

(now that we have flipped the nines, I will be doing the back nine first then finishing up with the front nine)

Question: My ball embedded in the front bank. I took relief under the "embedded ball rule" and when I dropped the ball, it ran down the hill. What do I do?

Answer: If it rolled more than 2-clublengths, you must drop a 2nd time. If it rolls again more than 2-clublengths, you must place it on a spot nearest to where the ball struck the ground.

Rule: 20-2c
