March is finally here (don't forget Daylight Savings Time begins March 13th)! Longer, warmer days are right around the corner. We will be completing our winter projects this month and will be spending all our time mowing. It has been a tough winter and the course is beginning to show signs of stress.

Renovation on bunkers #4 and #16 will begin this month. We will be removing old sand, improving drainage, preparing the bunker base and re-filling with new bunker sand. Once started, the work will take a few days to complete. Sorry for any inconvenience.

Drill aerification of the putting greens is scheduled for Monday, March 28th. The course will be closed until 11:00 am and all play will go off the first tee only. Check with the pro shop for available tee times. We will begin aerification of the tees and fairways some time later in the month of March prior to our insecticide treatment for mole crickets.

Turf Tip of the Month

It is time for broadleaf weed control and fertilization in your lawn. Dual-purpose products are available at your local home center. Obtain rates and procedures from your County Extension Agent. In Escambia County call 475-5230 and in Santa Rosa County call 623-3868. Be sure to mention the desired turf species of your lawn (herbicides are not safe to use on all turfgrasses).

Pro Tip of the Month

Feet together drill

Think you have a balance problem? This is a great way to check to find out. It is also a great drill to fix your imbalance.

Tee up a ball (always use a tee when doing any kind of drill), take a normal stance with a 7-iron, then narrow your stance together (no more than a club head apart), swing the club and finish with a normal follow through. Make sure your back heel is pointing at the sky. You should be able to do this without fighting to hold the follow through. If you can't do it, you have a balance problem and need to continue using the drill to fix it.

Rule of the month

Question: I damaged my club on a root while hitting a shot. The club head was bent a little. Can I still use it?

Answer: Yes. During a round you may use the damaged club as long as it was damaged during normal course of play. You can also use it in future rounds as long as the club is still conforming to the rules.
