One again, the concern is with wet playing conditions. We received 14.58" in April (34.95" so far this year). We continue to work on drainage problems including bunker drainage which greatly affects their playability.

We are well in to the transition period and I feel the greens are in very good condition. Positive comments are being heard throughout the course. The crew is very appreciative of the kind words, thank you. Because of the long hard winter, bermuda grass is reluctant to break dormancy. Green up is very evident and the plants are actively growing. Definition between the various playing surfaces will soon be evident.

Pro Tip of the Month

Nearly eight out of ten people I teach have a problem with keeping their right hand connected with their left (opposite for lefties) during the transition of their back swing and down swing. This problem will cause many of your miss hits like "pulling the ball", "snap pull hooks" & "topping the ball". One way to check to see if you have this problem is to take a back swing and stop it at the top. Then look at the palm of your right hand and see if it is still touching your left thumb. If there is any separation at all, you would be one of the eight I mentioned above. This is one of the most important pressure points of the grip. Keep pressure on your left thumb with right palm during transition to correct the problem. If you correct this problem, straighter and more solid shots will follow.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.

Turf Tip of the Month

How high or low should I mow my lawn? Recommended mowing heights differ depending up on the grass type. Note that grass is generally mowed higher in summer and lower during wet, cool periods in spring and fall. Recommended Mowing Heights in Inches:

<u>Bermudagrass</u>-.5" to 2" mowing height .5 to 1 pound of Nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing month.

Bahiagrass-2" to 4" mowing height.1 to .4 pounds of Nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing month **Zoysiagrass-** .75" to 2" mowing height .5 to 1 pound of Nitrogen per

1,000 sq. ft. per growing month <u>Centipedegrass</u>-1.5" to 2.5" mowing height .1 to .3 pounds of Nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing month

St. Augustinegrass-2" to 4" mowing height (most cultivars) .5 to 1 pound of Nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing month.

<u>Irrigate deep and infrequent to</u> promote deep rooting.

Rule of the month

Answer: Not in a water hazard. You can in a bunker but you must drop within the bunker
