September will be another busy month as we ready the course for Club Championship in early October.

This has been a difficult growing season. The turfgrass has had to endure periods of heavy rain and drought, heavy traffic, and numerous pests. All things considered, we have done very well. This month, we will apply a herbicide to begin the process of preparing the course for overseeding. We will apply winter seed to the tees in October & the greens in November and put the bermudagrass to sleep for a much-needed rest.

A winter work schedule is being put together at this time. The list includes drainage work, ornamental transplanting, irrigation repair, dead tree removal and brush clearing. Turf Tip of the Month

Late season fertilizer should contain a high percentage of Potassium. There are three numbers on a fertilizer analysis. The first number is Nitrogen, second is Phosphorus, and the last number is Potassium. Potassium is important for root development, increases plant hardiness, and aids in spring green up.
