On behalf of the maintenance staff, I would like to extend congratulations to the winners of all Club Championship flights.

The greens are recovering nicely from the end of August drill aerification, September will be another busy month as we ready the course

This has been a difficult growing season. The turfgrass has had to endure periods of drought and heavy rain, heavy traffic, and numerous pests (weeds being number one). This month, we will apply herbicide to begin the process of preparing the course for winter months and overseeding.

A winter work schedule is being put together at this time. The list includes bunker improvement, drainage work, irrigation repair, dead tree removal and brush clearing. Turf Tip of the Month

Late season fertilizer (now through October 2016) should contain a high percentage of Potassium. There are three numbers on a fertilizer analysis. The first number is Nitrogen, second is Phosphorus, and the last number is Potassium. Potassium is important for root development, increases plant hardiness, and aids

Here is an easy way to figure out if you are playing the correct tee markers.

On a normal day with little wind and about 15 yards of roll, if you are hitting more than a 5-iron into #1 after a good tee shot, you need to move up a set of tees.

Answer: you must replace the ball and add 1-penalty stroke.

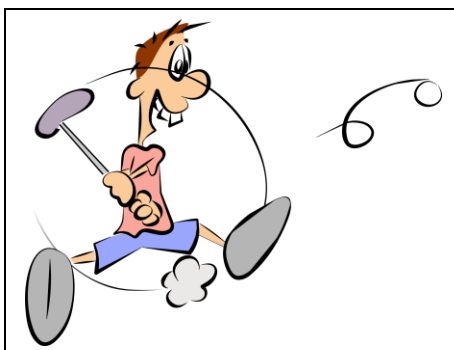
