This will be a trial period and hopefully it will go off without a hitch. Here is the procedure after going to our website (cypresslakesgolfclub.net):

- *Membership tab*
- *member tee times*
- *password: playnow*
- *choose your date*
- *select your time*
- *choose the rate (either 9 or 18 holes)*
 - *number of golfers*
 - *add to cart*
 - *check out*
- *enter name (only once after account created)*
 - *check the box "agree to terms"*
 - *checkout*
- *complete your purchase*

You will not be charged any amount at the time of booking. The charge will be made when checking in. If you are a walker, you would still book it this way but notify us when checking in that you will be walking. If you need to cancel, you can do it online unless it's within 24 hours. The turf is still transitioning from cool season to warm season grasses. By the middle of this month, the Bermuda grass should be filling in much better on our tees and greens. We will try to speed this up by verticutting, topdressing and small tine aerification.

Please remember that carts are always to be kept on paths around tees and greens. I have seen too many carts almost on the green surface. When we are "Cart path only" stay on the path the entire hole. When there are no cart paths, select a rough and stay in the rough for the entire hole. Do not cross the fairway. As a reminder, we will be closing the Driving Range on Tuesdays from 10:30am-1:00pm for mowing.

Thank you for your support as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

Tip of the month

Keep yourself and your turf hydrated, treat for summer annual weeds, and keep your mower blade sharp. Andy

Rule of the Month

Question: I played in a tournament and signed my scorecard for a score lower than my actual score. What's the ruling?

Answer: If the total score was incorrect but the hole-by-hole scores were correct there is no penalty. If a hole-by-hole score is higher you must keep that score. If a hole-by-hole score is lower you are disqualified.

Pro Tip of the Month

(oldie but goodie)

It's that time of the year.

If your hands sweat a lot, you probably wear a glove. To prolong the life of your gloves and for better performance, alternate them between holes. Never wear a glove for two holes in a row. In this heat, I rotate 3 gloves during the round. The gloves dry out before rotated back into play. Your gloves will last longer and perform better.

DO NOT leave your clubs in your trunk during the summer. The trunks get so hot that it can ruin your grips and it could also loosen the heads of your clubs.

Try these tips and I promise they will help your game.

- #6 tee: 125-149 yard avg. drive

Etiquette 101

When parking carts around tees and greens, make
sure all 4 tires remain on concrete. Constantly
pulling just off causes unnecessary wear and tear.
