We are excited to see what we will be dealt with this month. I was starting to think we would never see a day without rain. Thank you to everyone who did their best to stay out of the wet areas and off the fairways during our rainy period. Fortunately, we have dried out and somewhat caught up with mowing. We will be doing late summer preemergent herbicide applications to minimize Poa annua and other winter weeds.

I hope you are having a great summer. So far it has been slightly on the warm side. I generally prefer heat over cold, but by August I am starting to dream of those beautiful days that are slightly cooler. Usually, those days arrive consistently in October. Until we get there we will keep on grinding. Thank you for your support as we strive to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play golf.

Agronomy Tip:

Now is the time to start planning on fall preemergent herbicide for the fall. As we get to the end of the month you will want to stay away from high nitrogen fertilization and go with higher P&K rates.

Rule of the Month

Question: I played my shot from a penalty area but it did not get out of the penalty area and I could not find the ball. What are my options?

Answer: 1. You can replay it from the original spot in the penalty area with a 1 stroke penalty.

2. Take lateral relief from the spot the shot that got you in the penalty area last cross with a 1 shot penalty.

3rd. Take back-on-the-line relief by dropping your ball on a reference line going straight back from the spot the shot that got you in the penalty area last cross with a 1 shot penalty.

4th. Play from where the original ball was played that got you in the penalty area with a 1 shot penalty.

Rule: 17.2a

Pro Tip of the Month

I have been asked many times why is my USGA Ghin Index so much different than my Course handicap when I play the same course and tee every time? For example, Member A has a 12.1 index but is a 7 handicap from the #3 tees. Member A only plays here at Cypress Lakes and only plays the #3 tees. Why the discrepancy?

In a nutshell:

USGA indexes are determined by the Slope, Rating, and par of the course you play, in comparison to an average course's slope and rating. The USGA formula gets your score differentials of the best 8 of your last 20 scores (whether you play the same course or multiple courses). This 8-round index average is used to create your USGA index. Now, you take this USGA index and convert it to a course handicap depending on what course and tees you play.

The above Member A with a 12.1

USGA index would be:

13 handicap from our #1 tees

11 handicap from our #2 tees

7 handicap from our #3 tees

6 handicap from our #4 tees

2 handicap from our #5 tees

The 12.1 index was converted using the USGA formula using each tee's slope, rating and par.
