September should be a little less humid, if we can avoid getting any tropical systems coming our way. We are still busy with mowing and set up on a daily basis. This month we are also spraying pre and post herbicides to suppress weeds. Our continued goal is and always will be to improve the golf course. Some upcoming improvements include more cart path work and a project to start grinding down roots.

We had a couple key people move on and filled their positions with new faces. I was once again reminded that there is no substitute for experience. One of our biggest needs is someone who understands golf irrigation. Our system is old and needs constant updating. If you know of anyone who might be interested in helping us out, that has irrigation or golf maintenance experience, please have them contact me. (850-937-3821)

Cooler temperatures are sure to be coming soon and a little rain wouldn't hurt.

#### Turf tip:

Late season fertilizer should contain a high percentage of Potassium. There are three numbers on a fertilizer analysis. The first number is Nitrogen, second is Phosphorus, and the last number is Potassium. Potassium is important for root development, increases plant hardiness, and aids in spring green up.

# **Pro Tip of the Month**

Oldie but goodie

## Tighten up your heads.

If you have a driver, fairway wood, or hybrid that has an adjustable head, you need to tighten it up periodically (once per month). These type of heads have a tendency to loosen on their own. If not tightened, you can break the shaft and it is not cheap to replace it. If you need help with it, swing by my office and I'll be glad to do it for you.

# **Practice Tip:**

Based on an hour practice session

- 10 minutes putting
- 10 minutes chipping
- 10 minutes pitching
- 10 minutes bunkers
- 20 minutes range

Think about this:

2/3 or your strokes are short game shots, therefore it should make sense that 2/3 of your practice session should concentrate on the short game. *Practice smarter and play better.*
