I'm glad many of you are using the Member Portal to book tee times. Please note, to avoid future "no show" charges, you must cancel the tee time either on line or by calling the Pro Shop if it is less than 24 hours of your time.

We started using the white rings in the holes to help with wear and tear of the edges and to allow us to change cups every other day opposed to every day. This practice gives a better putting surface. The rings are very brittle so please be careful when getting you ball out of the hole. Avoid yanking the pin out to help remove the ball. It not only may break the ring but it might pull it up above the ground affecting the next group.

It is time again for overseeding our Tees. We will be watering more frequently until the seedlings have rooted. Please leave tee markers off to the side of the tee. We leave them in one area until most of the seed has established, then we go back and reseed areas that have been worn out. While the overseed is rooting on the driving range, we will need to be on the driving range mats for an extended period of time.

Please help us out by adhering to the daily cart path rules. We will most likely start getting rain sometime this month. During the dormant season, grass does not use as much water so when it gets wet it tends to stay wet longer than the growing season. We also start spraying herbicides for winter annuals this month. Thanks for your support as we try to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

<u>Turf Tip</u>

It is nearing time to put your mowers away for the winter. Be sure to fill the fuel tank and use a fuel stabilizer. This will prevent moisture from collecting and ensure longer engine life. Clean your mowers thoroughly to remove all clipping debris and buildup. Moisture collects in the buildup and causes mower decks to rust. During the winter months, sharpen mower blades and coat with a light film of oil to prevent rust.

Pro Tip of the Month

Check the angle of your club at address!

Make sure when you set up that your club is at a 45 degree angle to the ground. Every club in your bag except your putter should be 45 degrees at address and at IMPACT. The key to perfect contact is to return the club back to where it started. Easier said than done but at least start out in the correct position.


