Tip of the month:

If you overseed, the next 6 weeks are the best time to do it. Avoid high nitrogen fertilizer. Instead fertilize with higher rates of potassium. The first number is the amount of nitrogen (N), the second number is the amount of phosphate (P₂O₅) and the third number is the amount of potash (K₂O). These three numbers represent the primary nutrients: nitrogen(N), phosphorus(P), potassium(K).

Question: My ball is close to a tree, can I bend a branch (not break it) away from me so that I don't hit it when I swing?

Answer: No, you cannot bend or break any growing or attached natural object.

Rule: 8.1a

Pro Tip of the Month

Transition issues?

The transition is the moment in the swing you go from your backswing to your downswing. This fraction of a second sets the swing path of the club. If your ball is not starting on the correct line, you have a transition issue. Try starting your downswing with your hips (don't slide them, rotate them). This will help with dropping the club into "The Slot". Doing it smoothly with a good tempo will improve your ball striking. Quick & jerky transitions will cause your swing path & clubface angle to be all out of whack.
