#3 tee: 200-224 yard avg. drive

#4 tee: 175-199 yard avg. drive

#5 tee: 150-174 yard avg. drive

#6 tee:125-149 yard avg. drive

A word from your Golf Course Superintendent: Andy Woolston

Frost delays are as much of an inconvenience for superintendents as they are for you. Agronomic principles prevent us from allowing you to play on frosted turf. Each frost delay is unique and there is no set answer for handling frost. 38 degrees Fahrenheit (read at the maintenance shop thermometer) seems to be the magic number. If the air temperature in the shade is less than 38 degrees, frost remains. We will utilize all available resources to prepare the golf course for play as soon as possible following a frost delay. The dormant season is tuff on turf because it is not able to recover, so please use cart paths and stay on mats on the driving range when signs designate. We will try to be on grass on the weekends and on mats during the week. The end of another growing season is upon us. This means that Holidays are right around the corner. On behalf of the maintenance crew, I would like to thank you for all the support and wish you a safe and Happy Holiday Season. Thank you for your patience and cooperation as we do our best to make Cypress Lakes a fun place to play.

Tip of the month:

It is important to remove leaves from your lawn. If you can store and harvest leaves and debris, they will make great compost this time next year. Hold off on pruning ornamental trees and shrubs until mid-January to late February (only prune during months that end in "ARY"). Insect and disease damage is still possible if you prune too early.

Rules and regulations for handicap flag usage: Cart must NOT be driven:

- Within 15 feet of putting surface
- On steep slopes around putting greens.
- In wet and muddy areas
- Where prohibited by signs and ropes

Please Note: General Manager, Golf Course. Superintendent, or Golf Shop Personnel may restrict use of carts and or the usage of handicap flags at any time because of weather and/or ground conditions.

Pro Tip of the Month

Don't fix the wrong problem.

Before you make swing changes, make sure you diagnose the problem. It may be an easy fix. BUT, if you change the wrong thing, you now have multiple problems.

Your shot shape will tell you what needs to be fixed. If the ball starts at your target, then curves away from it, you need to fix the face angle. If the ball does not start at your target, you need to fix your swing path.

Fixes include but by no means are limited to: grip, setup & alignment, takeaway, hip rotation, transition issues, impact position, the release, or balance.

Fixing a problem is easier once you know what the problem is.

Rule of the Month

Question: Do I get free relief if my ball is embedded?

Answer: Yes, if your ball is embedded in the general area. You get 1 club length from the reference point (which is the area right behind where the ball is embedded) no nearer the hole.

Rule: 16.3b
