Turf Tip of the Month

January is a great month to get soil testing done. Any good interpretive program begins with testing. When a doctor evaluates a patient, he always runs a medical test before making a diagnosis. It should be no different with your soil. Soils need the right balance of nutrients to provide the optimum soil environment to allow for the proliferation of beneficial microorganisms. When soils are healthy the turf is better able to absorb the right nutrients and withstand stresses. Your county extension office can help with soil testing information.

Thank you Neal Johnson!

The Flag of the United States currently flying at Cypress Lakes Golf Club adjacent to the clubhouse was donated by one of our members, retired U.S. Navy Master Chief Neal Johnson. This Flag was presented to Master Chief Johnson from the Command Master Chief of USS Enterprise at the Inactivation Ceremony aboard Naval Base Norfolk, Virginia. This Flag had been flown during the ship's last deployment after departing Naples, Italy. Enterprise is the only aircraft carrier to house more than two nuclear reactors, having an eight-reactor propulsion design, with each reactor taking the place of one of the conventional boilers in earlier constructions. She is the only carrier with four rudders; two more than other carrier classes, and features a more cruiser-like hull. At 1,123 feet (342 m), she is the <u>longest naval vessel</u> ever built. Enterprise was, at the time of inactivation, the third-oldest commissioned vessel in the United States Navy after the wooden hulled USS Constitution and USS Pueblo. She was inactivated on 1 December 2012, and officially decommissioned on 3 February 2017, serving the U.S. Navy for 55 years!

Pro Tip of the Month

Constant Grip Pressure

Try to maintain the same grip pressure at transition not only when you swing but when you putt, chip, and pitch. Don't be too loose or too tight. Constant pressure will help avoid "flipping" the club at transition.
